Fifth And Sixth Graders use preteen Grapple which challenges them to engage ("grapple") with real life issues and questions as they strengthen their faith foundation.

Intentional faith development continues with classes for youth and adults.

Junior and High School Students and Adults are engaged in a choice of Bible study, personal faith development, and contemporary issues of faith.

The Let's Talk Adult classes - provides the opportunity to share topics of interest. Discussions are facilitated by class members. Topics range broadly; microeconomics as a tool to reduce world poverty, and the faith of the founding fathers. Books/DVDs which have sparked discussion include "Speaking of Faith" by Krista Tippett, William P Young's novel "The Shack", and "Three Simple Rules: A Wesleyan Way of Life".
