Our Inspiration

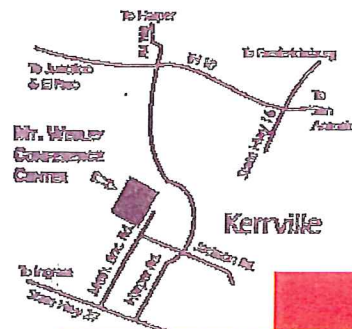
- Bishop James Dorff**—San Antonio Episcopal Area Bishop Jim Dorff presides over the San Antonio Area of the United Methodist Church. This Area includes the Southwest Texas and Rio Grande Annual Conferences. There are 420 United Methodist Churches with 135,000 members in the Area. - Rev. Dr. Terry Teykl**—An elder in the Texas Annual Conference of the United Methodist Church, Terry is a “prayer evangelist” traveling across the U.S. and around the world encouraging churches to develop and maintain prayer ministries. He also serves as the “prayer pastor” at Faithbridge UMC in Spring, Texas. His warm sense of humor, honesty and genuine compassion delight audiences of all backgrounds. - Dick O’Neal**—“Lefty” has played baseball since he could wrap his hands around a ball. Since his retirement as a United States Air Force Officer, where he served for more than twenty years, he has functioned in several capacities, including adjunct professor in the speech communication field; part-time corporate training consultant; motivational speaker; member of the Fellowship of Christian Athletes executive board of San Antonio, TX; and vice president of the South Texas Professional Baseball Negro League Players’ Association. He is also a professional baseball scout. He wrote ‘Dreaming of the Majors-Living in the Bush’ both to bring a part of history to life and to testify to God’s constant care and love in the lives of himself, his family and the other lives he has touched in his life’s journey. His book was placed in the Baseball Hall of Fame Library in Cooperstown, NY in April of 2009. Lefty and his wife Harriett have been married for more than 36 years and have two adult children, Amy and Richard Adam. The O’Neal family calls Universal City, TX their home.
