

The Austin District United Methodist Men Steering Committee stands ready to assist you. We offer a couple of avenues of support:

1. Local President's Training - We offer a Men's Ministry Action Plan (MMAP). This training is over a two day period; three hours on Friday evening and four hours on a Saturday morning. This is a process whereby a core leadership team from your men's group, one of which should be the men's group president, would come together to:
  - a. create a purpose statement for your men's group
  - b. find ways to manage momentum in your group in three areas
    - o create momentum
    - o capture momentum
    - o sustain momentum
  
2. Motivational Presentation - This would be tailored to the unique needs of your men's group. A presentation may contain these elements:
  - a. Devotional and Motivational – Identify a sense of God's calling for your men's group.
  - b. Informational – Be informed on UMM organization such as chartering, EMS (Every Man Shares in Evangelism, Mission, and Spiritual Life), Legacy Builders, etc.

The context of this type of presentation could be in the form of a program for a morning or an evening meeting.
