Iglesia Metodista Emmanuel

Food For The Children

A program for children of Quito's service workers and vendors who reside in outlying locations. The children are picked-up by Emmanuel UMC in Quito, are brought to the church for homework help, a Bible lesson, and a Hot meal before they go off to school in the afternoon. Emmanuel can fund the program for 50 children 2 days a week.



Proposal:

VBS and lunch for 1 week.

Long term: Sponsor a child for \$20 per month?

Iglesia Metodista El Mesías

Construction –2011

El Mesías is nearby Quito. The long range plan is to build a community center, to work with the children in the area. This would be built on the vacant lot adjoining the church.



Proposal:

The roof of the sanctuary needs to be replaced. The wooden braces on which the roof rests also needs attention. In some places, the leaking roof has caused the wood to rot. We probably could not have VBS while the work is going on. The 2011 plan is for 1 team to remain in Quito and 1 travel about 20 minutes to fix the roof.
