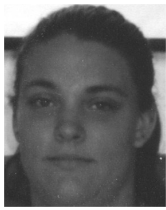

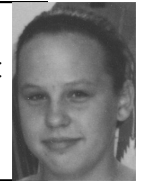
What are they saying about School of Christian Missions? Here is what the young ladies that attended in 2008 want you to know. Come join them at Mount Union in July!
