Minutes of August 4, 2009 meeting

In attendance: Gary Mahler, Alane O'Connor, Kevin Wellenius

Meeting began at 6:05pm.

Item 1: Update on project to rebuild dog kennels

Kevin provided an update that the July workday accomplished demolition of old kennel, identified salvageable material, compiled new material list, and set three of the new corner posts. Second workday will be required, plus additional drop-in tasks. Committee agreed to proposed plan to split costs three ways between MOC, Pastor's discretionary fund, and homeowner. Total projected costs are approximately \$1200 (\$800 for chainlink material, up to \$400 for kennel materials). Next workday to be scheduled for August 15 or 22 depending on Ken Weaver's availability.

[Update: August 15 workday was chosen, and project was mostly finished. Ken Weaver and Tom Crable finalized remaining items since then. Peter has installed the chain link fence.]

Item 2: Replace bathroom door to facilitate wheelchair access for home in Oakland.

Kevin relayed info from Bill Meyer that a person in Oakland needed a wider bathroom door. Ken Weaver to do this solo given small scope and need for skilled persons. MOC to pick up cost of a new door (est. at \$140)

Item 3: Need to decide on whether we will offer emergency firewood assistance this winter. To be discussed next meeting.
