CO-OP CITY UNITED METHODIST CHURCH IS CONSECRATED

The Consecration Service for the newly constructed Co-Op City United Methodist Church took place on Sunday, May 22, 2005. United Methodists from across the Conference, friends of the Church and Members of the Community, joined Rev. Dr. Milca Alvarez-Plaud and the Co-Op City congregation for this special event.

The act of consecration was led by Bishop Jeremiah Park, who also preached the sermon. Bishop Park was joined in the consecration by Rev. Noel N. Chin, District Superintendent of the Metropolitan District, and Rev. Dr. Clyde Anderson, Executive Director of the United Methodist Society.

The Service included musical presentations by members of the church; a presentation of the history of the project by Rev. Dr. Alvarez-Plaud and Mr. Carlos Alvarez, and greetings from a number of individuals, including Rev. Carol Matteson Cox, former District Superintendent of the Metropolitan North District.

Rev. Johnny Ceasar is appointed to serve at St. Paul's in Hartsdale.

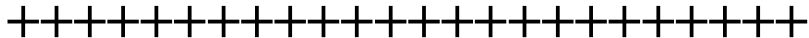

A REPORT ON THE STATE OF OUR DISTRICT

THE 2004 – 2005 CHURCH CONFERENCES

The 2004-2005 Church Conferences began in September 2004 and ended in February 2005. Some of them were single conferences, while several were joint or group conferences, involving more than one church. The joint and group conferences were indicative of an increased level of collaboration between our churches.

Ministry in this district and this conference is rewarding, but also challenging. As I participated in the Church Conferences, I identified some challenges that call for follow-up work in the future. These challenges could be grouped in the following categories:

1. Membership Growth
2. Financial Challenges
3. Building Maintenance Issues
4. Leadership Development

HEALTH INSURANCE

Our connectional responsibility requires that every church served by a fulltime pastor pay the uniform rate. This rate is each fulltime church's equal share of the total Annual Conference premium that provides health benefits for active clergy, conference staff, and their families throughout our conference.

The uniform rate for 2005 is \$11, 160. Each church pays 90% (\$10, 044) billed at \$837 per month, while each pastor pays 10% (\$1116) billed at \$93 per month.

As of April 30, 2005, most churches were current with their payments. However, a number of churches were facing serious arrearages. At that date, our total district contribution was at 29% of the annual premium and not the 33% that it should have been.

PENSION

In 2007, the General Board of Pensions and Health Benefits will begin a new Pension Program. In preparation for this new plan, the Board offered incentives to conferences to begin using the modified direct billing procedure (i.e. conferences bill local churches directly). Our conference began using this procedure on January 1, 2005. A consequence of this program is that the conference has to send the entire amount of our pension payments monthly to the Board. The General Board will receive and deposit partial payments in an escrow account but not credit any pastor's account until the entire conference bill has been received. The Board has graciously agreed to extend the deadline for implementing this policy. However, this extension will expire soon.

At the end of April 2005, we had remitted 28% of our obligation as a district. This was 5% below the 33% we should have paid at that point.

A number of churches also have outstanding balances from 2004. Across the conference, \$58,000 in pension payments are owed. The total outstanding for churches in our district is almost \$20,000.
