

COVENANT TO LIVE IN A CARING COMMUNITY

One of the purposes of The Pinelands Center at Mt. Misery is to provide an atmosphere in which all persons, Campers, Staff, and Guests, may experience a loving, caring community. One of the ways to accomplish this is for everyone to agree to some basic standards by which we will attempt to live while at the Pinelands Center. Below is a simple covenant that we ask all campers and staff to sign.

I will relate to other campers, camp staff, and all other persons at the Pinelands Center with care, concern, and respect.

My behavior and language will be in keeping with the standards established by the Pinelands Center.

I will care for and preserve the environment and facilities while enjoying God’s wonderful creation.

I will not leave camp property without the knowledge and permission of the Site Director.

I will show respect for the property, body, and feelings of all persons.

If I choose not to abide by this covenant, the Site Director may, in addition to other corrective measures, limit participation in specific activities or call my parent/guardian to take me home.
