The purpose of this survey sheet is to identify your areas of interest. It is not a commitment to work a specific task on a specific walk. As the walks draw closer a sign-up sheet will be passed around the gatherings so you will be able to select when and where you would like to help out. If you sign-up for a particular task please make a note of the time and task and be prepared to follow through. If you find that you are unable to perform the task you have volunteered for, please notify the background coordinator so a replacement can be identified. Remember, "Christ is counting on you."

Camp Set Up: The Tuesday prior to a walk beginning at 4:00pm.

Sweep, Mop, scrub, vacuum, disinfect – toilets, rugs, dishes, floors, porches, and more.

Move chairs, tables, podiums, and boxes, and boxes, and boxes.

All are welcome (Trucks and strong backs are especially needed).

Worship

Set up all altars: sponsor's hour, chapel, dining room, candlelight, and closing. Iron linens, placing items on altars according to instructions.

Provide communion bread for the weekend.

3 day task interrupted briefly by short breaks (3-4 person crew) some altars may be prepared Tuesday

Registration

Before the pilgrims arrive help place names in rooms.

Give out name badges and greet arriving pilgrims.

Thursday 5:00pm – 7:00pm

Luggage and Bed Making

Greet arriving pilgrims and team as guests. Carry luggage and escort to rooms.

Make beds after pilgrims leave for conference room.

Thursday 6:30 – 8:00ish

Send Off

Make snacks for send off buffet. *(You can send these if you are not able to attend)*

Clean up.

Attend to greet and mingle.

Thursday 6:00pm – 9:00pm

Sponsor's Hour

Pray for pilgrim's cross as we place their cross on the large wooden cross.

Music

You do not have to have a pilgrim to participate.

Thursday 7:30 – 9:00 pm -ish.

Kitchen (food prep)

Help prepare food 3-4 Hours prior to meals.

Day-long task interrupted briefly by short breaks (3-4 person crew)

Kitchen (servers)

- Dishwashers *after meals – come for a meal or the whole day*
- Clean up and rearrange tables
- Food servers (*Remember – NO WATCHES, and no bright colors until Saturday at Lunch*) Come about 30 minutes early and stay to clean up.
 - Friday Breakfast (8am) Lunch (12:30pm) Dinner (5:30pm)
 - Saturday Breakfast (8am) Lunch (12:30pm) Dinner (5:30pm)
 - Sunday Breakfast (8am) Lunch (12:00pm)

Snack Agape

- Make snacks for the weekend. (Please remember to send enough for approx. 65 people).
- Tend the snack room to be prepared for breaks
- Decorate for celebration after candlelight.
3 Day task interrupted briefly by short breaks (2-3 person crew)

Prayer Chapel

- Pray with the speakers and for the pilgrims, community, concerns. You may know the speaker and you may not. It is always a good place to be. If you have time between tasks, stop in and pray a while. You may give a special blessing to pray with your table leader, someone you have sponsored, walked with, or someone you trained in an area.

Agape

- Make agape (65 pieces per walk)
- Distribute agape to dining room, conference room and dorms. Sort letters, make beds.
3 Day task interrupted briefly by short breaks (3 – 4 person crew)

Photo

- Take picture and get names Friday near 10:00am
- Get pictures printed.
- Type names for line up on back of picture.
- Make copies of names list and picture and return to Agape room Sat. am.

After Dinner Entertainment

- Music, skit, storytelling, comedy, etc. (Something light-hearted)
Saturday Evening 5:00pm – 7:00pm

Candlelight

- Prepare candles prior to candlelight
- Set out luminaries. Distribute and light candles as people leave the building to line up for candlelight. Help collect candles as people enter the building at the beginning and as they exit the building at the end of candlelight. Pick up luminaries and move boxes out of sight. (*If this is your first candlelight on the background side, just enjoy*)
- Music
- Participate in Candlelight
Fellowship, music, message, prayer for pilgrims, and communion.
Saturday Evening 8:00pm – 10:45pm

Camp Clean Up (Begins after lunch on Sunday)

- Take down, box up, put back the camp
- Sweep, mop, scrub, vacuum, disinfect – toilets, rugs, dishes, floors, porches, and more.
- Move chairs, table, podiums, and boxes, and boxes, and boxes.
- Special help needed after the pilgrims leave conference room. If you do not have a pilgrim on the walk please consider helping during this time. If you have a pilgrim you will want to be at closing.
All welcome (Trucks and strong backs are sometimes needed).
