**(PLEASE NOTE THE CHANGE OF THE REGISTRATION LOCATION)**

- ARRIVAL** Upon arrival to WCSU (western campus, ext 4 off I-84) proceed to **Centennial Hall** to register. (Parking right across from the dorm in front of the Campus Center.)
- REGISTRATION** Opens at 8:00 AM and closes at 10:00AM Thursday in **Centennial Hall**. You will only be picking up your room key / meal card. Your packets will be in your room.
- SCHEDULE** **THURSDAY**; Breakfast is on your own. School opens promptly at 10:00 AM in the Student Center Ballroom. Please plan to be in your seat and ready to begin on time.
- ORIENTATION** **Orientation** will be at **9:30 AM** in the **Ball Room**, all are welcome.
- YOUTH MEETING WITH SPONSORS** **MEET IN THE PRESIDENT LOUNGE, "CLASSROOM BUILDING", 2:45 PM**
- KEY/KEY CARD** Issued and signed for at registration. **\$25** charge for lost key card.
- LINENS** Provided: sheets, pillow, pillowcase, light blanket, towels and washcloth. You may wish to bring your own pillow, blanket, towels and mattress pad. Linens will be distributed on the floor your dorm room is on.
- DORMITORY** All buildings are air conditioned, but we have to share the bathroom in your suite. There is also a living room, one bathroom. We can NOT raise & lower beds. Step stools will be provided if needed.
- WHAT TO BRING** Your bible, note book, pen/pencil, a tote bag for your books and handouts, and wear comfortable shoes (you will be walking to different buildings). You may wish to bring clothes hangers, a sweater, fan, desk lamp and umbrella. Bring your own toiletries.
- EMERGENCY #** **WCSU Police department is open 24 hours a day. The phone # is 203-837-9300.**
- RESOURCE RM.** Open 8:00 AM to 10:00 AM on Thursday. For other times, see schedule upon arrival.
- CANCELLATIONS** \$35 of your total registration fee is non-refundable after the deadline, **July 10th**. Cancellations and **NO SHOWS**, the amount charged to us by WCSU will be deducted. Registrations are **NOT** transferable without permission by the Registrar before School starts.

The Connecticut Food Bank is an affiliate of America's Second Harvest--The Nation's Food Bank Network. It is the largest centralized source of donated, emergency food in Connecticut. They provide food products to more than 650 soup kitchens, shelters, food pantries and daycare programs throughout Connecticut.

**Food items most needed:** (No fresh produce; non-perishable items only): 100% Fruit Juice (cans/bottles/boxes), Canned vegetables & Fruit, Chunky Soups & Beef Stew, Macaroni & Cheese, Powdered Milk, Rice/Dry & Canned Beans, Spaghetti & Sauce, "Sugar Free," "Low Sodium," & "No Salt" items, Tuna & Other Canned Meats.

**Personal Care Items Most Needed:** Shampoo, Toothpaste, and Toothbrushes, Diapers, Detergent, and Deodorant, Shaving Cream, Razors, and Hairbrushes. If you are unable to bring any of the above items to SOM, you can make a cash donation.

**To get to WCSU, "Westside Campus"**

**(From the West or New York)**

- Route I-684 to I-84 East, (where I-84 & Route 7 meet)
- Take Exit 4 off I-84 (stay on the exit ramp till the end).
- Turn right onto Lake Avenue.
- Go approximately one mile.
- Campus entrance is on the right across from Super Stop & Shop.
- Once you are on campus follow the signs to Centennial Hall (the dorms)
- We suggest you leave your bags in your car until you know where your room is.

**(From the North or East)**

- Take Exit 4 off I-84 (stay on the exit ramp till the end).
