A **REQUEST** we are making this year is:

## HEALTH KITS for our OC school teachers

Because their salaries are low they cannot afford many items that we take for granted, and they would really enjoy receiving an encouraging “perk!”

- 1 bath towel (average size)
- 1 washcloth
- 1 lightweight blanket or flannel sheet
- 1 tube toothpaste (4.5 oz. or larger), and 1 toothbrush  
*(both in original wrapping)*
- 1 bar soap (bath-size) *(in original wrapping)*
- 1 can talc powder or bottle of body lotion  
*(put into small Ziploc bag)*
- 1 bottle multi-vitamins *(expiration date no earlier than Nov. 2010)*
- 1 bottle Tylenol *(expiration date no earlier than Nov.2010)*
- 1 small bottle hand-sanitizer, such as Purell  
*(put into small Ziploc bag)*



**INSTRUCTIONS:** To pack the kit, place all other items onto the lightweight blanket or sheet. Fold up so that everything will be secure inside. Then place the bundle inside a 2-gallon Ziploc, other plastic bag secured with tape, or a plastic storage container. **Label your package: “1 teacher health kit”.**

Please bring **\$1.00 per kit for shipping...** *(do not put money into in Ziplock bog or box).*

**If you are bringing several kits**, please box them and indicate on the sealed box that it contains teacher health kits, and specify how many.
