

WAYS TO ASSIST KISSY

All gifts are tax deductible.

- ◆ Salary Support for Dr. Marke. Dr. Marke is key to the ongoing success of the medical program at Kissy and its outreach throughout Sierra Leone. Funds from the operation of the clinic are insufficient to support Dr. Marke.
- ◆ Provide funds for nutrition program. It costs \$1 to feed a child. Most children are on the program 60 days
- ◆ Purchase of medications and prescription drugs. Many persons treated at the clinic do not have funds to purchase medications.
- ◆ Shipment of medical supplies. Much of the supplies and equipment we ship comes from US clinics or hospitals. They donate the supplies and equipment but usually do not assist in the shipping costs.
- ◆ HIV/AIDS education. \$2000 will provide materials and staff for HIV/AIDS testing, and education in one school.
- ◆ Provide benevolent care. Many patients are unable to pay for the services they need and they have no insurance. A benevolent care fund has been established.

HANDS-ON MEDICAL PROJECTS

You may provide any of these medical items:

- Children's chewable vitamins *(an unlimited supply is needed)*
- Tylenol *(Adult and Children)*
- Acetaminophen *(non-aspirin pain relievers; all strengths)*
- Anti-diarrheal preparations *(Imodium, etc.)*
- Antibiotic ointments *(Bacitracin,)*
- Antipruritics *(hydrocortisone ointments for relief of rashes & itching)*
- Anti-acids *(Mylanta, Maalox)*
- Cold medications *(decongestants, antihistamines, and cough suppressants - also with acetaminophen)*
- Sterile bandages *(BandAids - 4 x 4's - telfa, etc., and tape)*
- Cleansing solutions *(antibacterial, Betadine, etc.)*
- Surgical gloves
- Oral Rehydration Salts - *to combat dehydration)*
- Rolled bandages
- Toothbrushes and toothpaste
- Sheets and pillow cases
- Nonperishable baby food
- Cream of Wheat
- Enfamil and Similac
