**1. Number of visits**

1. Number of visits per week 14 patients.

**2. Reason for visits.**

1. To reduce the level of malnutrition cases and diseases related to malnourished children in Sierra Leone.
2. To know the number of death, and the causes of death.
3. To know if the families can prepare their own therapeutic feeding and practice safe health habits.
4. To know if families can respond to health related emergencies in time of out breaks. E.g diarrhea.

3. Growth monitoring.
