

SUNDAY SCHOOL CLASSES OFFERED

Eureka

Room 205

This class, taught by Heard Butler and Billy Rhodes, is composed of 35 members. They range in age from 45-70, getting together once a quarter for social functions. They study the Wesley Bible Series and have a lecture-discussion format. Their president is Billy Rhodes.

Aldersgate

Room 204

This class, composed of people aged 50 plus, is taught by Sam Cousley, Darryail Whittington, Larry Britt, and Robert Northern. They have about 20 members and are currently using the Wesley Adult Bible Study. They describe their class as having informal discussion on Bible oriented topics. The class president is Larry Britt.
