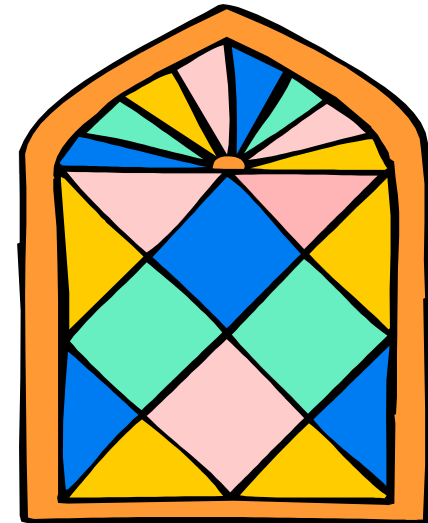

Parish Health Ministry Information
