The introduction of a John Wesley Fellow into the Society recognizes United Methodist laity or clergy for distinguished service to the church.

Selection of a John Wesley Fellow may be made by a United Methodist Men's unit in recognition of distinguished service to local church mission and ministry.

The recognition made available by the United Methodist Men Foundation is designed to promote greater awareness of the Christian principles and practices embodied in the United Methodist Church and the development of these values.

Guidelines for Naming and Presenting a John Wesley Fellow

Membership

A recipient of the John Wesley Fellow Award should be a member of the United Methodist Church.

Frequency

The John Wesley Fellow Award may be presented at any time by a United Methodist Men's unit.

Selection

The selection of a John Wesley Fellow recipient should be made on the basis of service and carry an endorsement by the United Methodist Men's President and the pastor of the local church.

Presentation

The John Wesley Fellow Award presentation should be made in a regular church service.

Nomination Procedures

The John Wesley Fellow nomination form is included on the back of this brochure.

Completed forms are submitted with a check to the United Methodist Men Foundation.

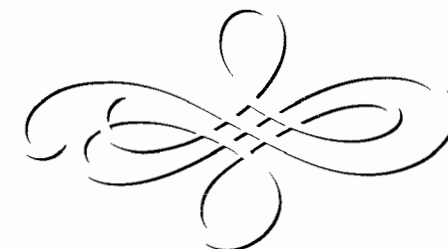
Contribution

About the Society

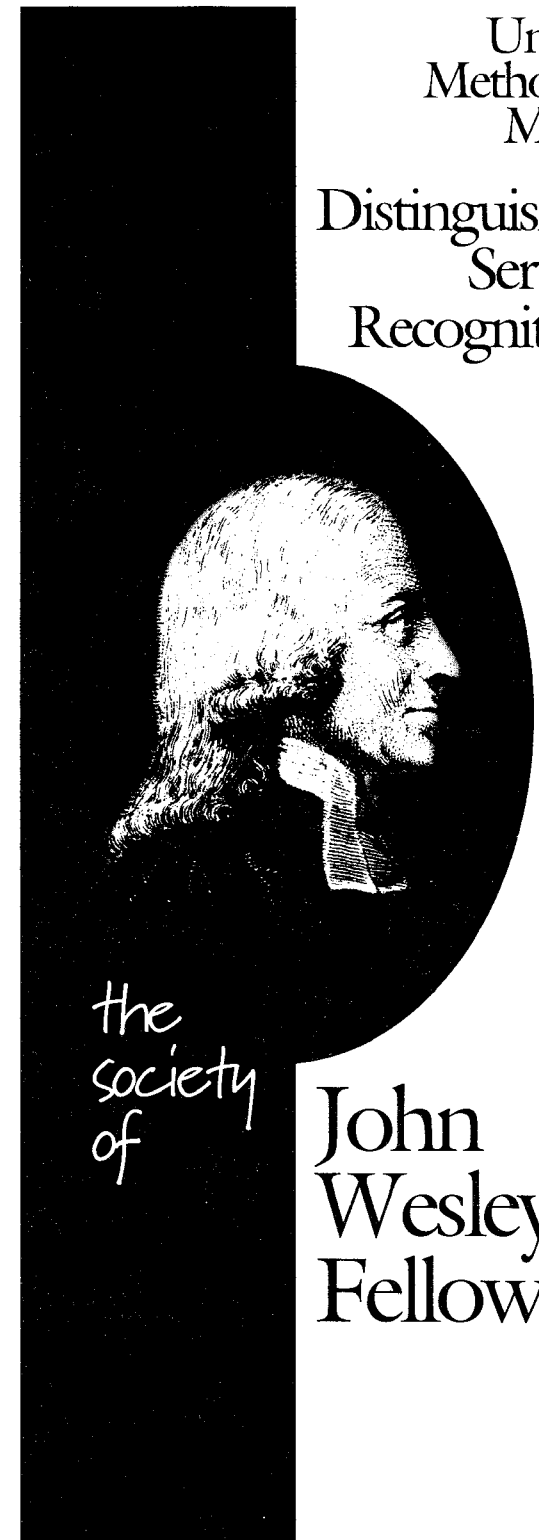
