Wesley-Rankin Community Center  
3100 Crossman Street  
Dallas, Texas

This center is located in western Dallas, one of the city's largest low-income sections. While most of the clientele is Mexican American, there are also African Americans, Native Americans, and Anglos. Many cultural groups come together in Wesley-Rankin's programs, which include direct services, education, and counseling. A church next door also serves as a senior citizens' center. With other local agencies, Wesley-Rankin engages in community organizing, and it has begun a project to deal with abandoned housing. An infant care program was recently introduced, and the center was instrumental in setting up a catering business for a group of women.

Black Community Developers

This program serves a community in transition with programs for families, youth, singles, couples, and the elderly. Services include counseling and legal referral. There are a pre-school, a tutorial program, and a full-time shelter for recovering female drug addicts.

Camp Aldersgate

Aldersgate was established in 1947 to encourage growth in Christian living. It provided a unique and critical service in the 1950's and 1960's by bringing together black and white groups for leadership training and workshops on social and racial concerns from a Christian perspective. Since the 60's, the emphasis has shifted to children and adults with physically and mentally handicapping conditions. Programs include summer medical camps for youth, senior citizens' social activities, community clinic and emergency services, and respite for care providers.

The South Central Jurisdiction Conference and Retreat Center was established in 1922 as the Western Methodist Assembly. It offers training as disciples in church leadership for Christ's service. Jurisdiction and national events are offered on conference and district levels for Methodist leadership. It offers personal response and renewal as partners as they act on the transformational ministries.

Precious Moments Chapel

Inspired by Michaelangelo's Sistine Chapel in Rome, Samuel J. Butcher designed and constructed the Precious Moments Chapel as his way of sharing the joy of his faith with the world. He used his Precious Moments messengers to bring well known and loved stories from the Bible to life in dozens of murals.
