This year's theme is "Crossing Boundaries – Journey in Hope." Scripture suggests that we should not only feel responsibility for those closest to us, but that we have a responsibility for hospitality to strangers. God calls us to step out boldly across boundaries into unfamiliar territory, to discern God's spirit leading us into new relationships, and to love all God's children as reflections of God's image.

Three mission studies will be offered

• **Creating Interfaith Community** - Participants will learn the theological and contemporary issues involved in creating interfaith community and its implications for global mission; and how people of different faiths get along and do good together.

• **Mexico: Labyrinth of Faith** - Among the world's poor and oppressed today, we find many persons of Mexican heritage both within Mexico and in the United States. How does our passion for God's mission link us in partnership with Christians in Mexico to show love of these neighbors? Participants will explore past and current relationships with Mexico.

• **Exodus** - This will be an opportunity to look at the story of the escape from Egypt of the Hebrew people.

These mission-education opportunities will expand your understandings of the world, the Bible, United Methodist mission outreach and the role of Christians in society.
