The purpose of Wesley Little Learners is to provide a preschool experience for young children. Classes are offered with the idea of contributing to the child's wholesome growth and development as a citizen.

The school offers non-sectarian activities and curriculum. Religious doctrine will not be taught.

An environment will be provided based on love and acceptance, in which young children can grow physically, socially, emotionally, and intellectually.

We believe that young children are better prepared for kindergarten when they have learning experiences with other children their age for a few hours a day in preschool.

## Who may enroll?

Children must be 3 years old by August 31 and be potty trained before attending preschool. Classes of 12 children each are mixed ages.

Wesley Little Learners is a preschool that celebrates all children in an inclusive environment. It recognizes diverse needs, abilities, interests, and cultures in a setting where each child is valued and respected as a unique individual developing at his/her own rate. All young children and their families are welcome without regard to race, gender, ability, family structure or socio-economic background.

## What does it cost?

A non-refundable registration/supply fee of \$20 is required upon pre-enrollment. No additional supplies required. Tuition is paid monthly August through April.

## Are scholarships available?

Partial scholarships may be available. Income guidelines apply. The preschool is also SRS approved as a childcare provider.

## When may I enroll my child?

Current students and their siblings may enroll beginning March 1.

Open enrollment begins in April.

## When do preschool classes begin?

Wesley Little Learners Preschool follows the Parsons USD #503 school calendar. Days off for holidays, snow days, vacation, etc. are the same as Parsons District.

## What will my child learn?

Wesley Little Learners offers opportunities for your child to grow in the following ways:

4. readiness for academic learning
5. problem-solving skills
6. ability to express themselves correctly
7. appreciation and enjoyment of a variety of children's books, games, songs, and activities which will include Christian values and objectives
8. appreciation of the world around them.

## How are these implemented?
