

Position Available Now: Student Documentary Filmmaker

Stipend: \$5,000

Employment Status: Contract; 15 month project

Nature of work: Produce 45-minute documentary

Description: Document the demolition of an existing multi-faith religious institution building and the rebuilding of a Build-it-Green, spiritual, multi-ethnic intentional housing community for students adjacent to Cal's campus incorporating stories and motifs of stewardship of human and natural resources, the existential questions of life, and the liminality of death and new life.

Requirements: Must be Cal student. Must provide or have access to camera and editing equipment. Strong interpersonal skills and ability to interview architect, development and construction team, board members, students and alums. Prior documentary experience required. Senior or grad student and interest in spirituality preferred. Must be a self-starter with ability to manage time.

Compensation: Stipend for 15-month position to create a 45-minute documentary \$5,000.
